Aim of the Study

To highlight the rare case of an isolated blunt traumatic ureteric injury in a normal kidney in a child.

Description

A previously healthy 8-month-old child was found to have right perinephric collection following blunt trauma. Percutaneous drainage of the collection done drained urine. Attempts at stenting the right ureter in a retrograde manner failed. We had to explore and repair the right pelviureteric junction through a right 12th rib incision. Post-operatively he is well.

Conclusion

High suspicion of ureteric injury is required in order not to miss the diagnosis.
